<i>Musca autumnalis</i> Face Fly	Sponging feeder	In fresh cow manure	Winter: Indoor swarms Summer: stay outside	Fly-bother Mechanical vector: pinkeye (<i>Morexella bovis</i>)	In-feed insecticides, Sprays, dusts, ear tags, rubs, parasitoid wasps
<i>Stomoxys calcitrans</i> Stable Fly	Piercing mouth parts: Blood feeder	In decaying vegetable matter (hay, straw, silage)	Outdoors on outside wall. Rarely goes indoors	Extremely painful bites Fly-bother, weight loss, low productivity	Eliminate decaying vegetation (breeding habitat) Sprays, dusts, ear tags, rubs, parasitoid wasps
<i>Haematobia irritans</i> Horn fly	Piercing mouth parts: Blood feeder	In fresh cow manure	Always on host's back, don't go indoors	Fly-bother, weight loss low productivity	In-feed insecticides, Sprays, dusts, ear tags, rubs, traps, vacuums
